April 20, 1918 - February 6, 2013

Angela E. Higgins (nee Wilusz), 94 years, of Sylvania Ohio, passed away on Wednesday morning February 6, 2013 in the Flower Hospital after a brief illness. She was born in Toledo Ohio on April 20, 1918 to Walter and Mary Wilusz. She grew up in the Polish Village and graduated from Whitmer High School.

Angie lived a joyful and faith-filled life. She had an unwavering devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and prayed the Rosary twice daily. Angie believed in miracles.

Angie was beloved by all who knew her. And those who knew her will remember her as a fierce competitor who was always up for a spirited game of Scrabble ("Qi is a word—look it up!"), bridge or penny-ante poker. Angie also enjoyed her beautiful garden, and the fish pond built by her son, Rick.
