



Cloyd A. Payne, Jr.

December 19, 1939 - June 24, 2012

Cloyd suffered a stroke on June 17th and was brought to St. Luke's Hospital. His condition worsened and he was transferred to the University Hospital in Cleveland, where he died on June 26th peacefully in the grace of our Lord. He was a Professor in Mathematics at the Owens Community College and the University of Toledo. He was known as "Dr. Payne" to his students. He loved and enjoyed teaching, as well as relating to students and faculty. He was a person with quiet disposition, great sense of humor and amazing talents. Cloyd loved music and was an accomplished pianist. He had played at many church functions, civic and social organizations. He was a current volunteer pianist at St. Joan of Arc Church. Cloyd was a person who was always willing to help others and gives of himself selflessly.

Cloyd is survived by his wife, Ami; daughter, Amina; step-son, Michael, sisters, Nancy Klein and Rosalie David; brother Keith Payne; nieces, nephews, in-laws, other relatives and loving friends.

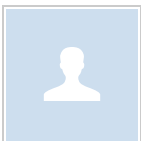
