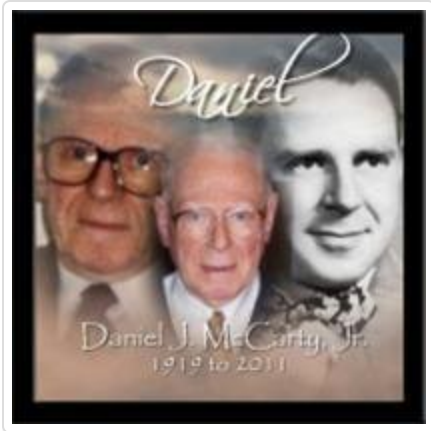




Daniel Joseph McCarty Jr.

March 3, 1919 - November 23, 2011

Daniel J. McCarty, Jr., age 92, passed away peacefully at home from natural causes on Wednesday, November 23, 2011. He lived at Lutheran Village at Wolf Creek since 2003.

Dan was born on March 3, 1919 to Dr. Daniel J. and Eleanor (Thienes) McCarty. He was their only child and grew up in Boston. He attended Boston Latin School, Holy Cross College and received a Masters of Library Sciences degree from Syracuse University. He married Mary Ruth Knue on August 22, 1953 in Indianapolis. The couple lived in Ann Arbor, MI for 50 years. He worked as an industrial librarian at Federal Mogul Corp. and Kerr/Sybron Dental. Among Dan's interest were his religion, visiting relatives, golf, crossword puzzles, Scrabble and UM football. He was also very active as an investor in the stock market.

Dan was preceded in death by his wife, Mary who died November 18, 2007. He is survived by his sons, John (Kathy) and Stephen of Holland, Ohio; grandchildren, Kevin and Colleen and several nieces and nephews.
