Rev. Edward V. Canavan, O.S.F.S. passed away on October 19, 2016 at Rosary Care Center, Sylvania, OH at the age of 81. Fr. Canavan was born to Edward and Adeline Canavan on May 19, 1935 in Niagara Falls, NY. He received a Philosophy degree in 1959 from the Catholic University of America. He made his first profession as an Oblate of St. Francis de Sales in 1954 and after completing graduate studies at DeSales School of Theology was ordained to the priesthood in 1964.

After ordination, Fr. Canavan taught at Northeast Catholic High School in Philadelphia, PA. Two years later he volunteered to serve in the Oblate missions in Brazil, where he ministered until 2000. Upon his return to the United States, he resided first at Welch Cottage in Brooklyn, Michigan, and then at Rosary Care Center, Sylvania, MI.

Fr. Ed touched the lives of thousands in Brazil and the United States. Oblate Superior General Fr. Aldino Kiesel, OSFS, a Brazilian himself, wrote: "Fr. Ed was much loved by the people in Brazil. He touched people with his humility and kindness, always taking plenty of time to listen to people. He was especially dedicated to the sick and the poor."

In retirement, Fr. Ed was an avid reader and deeply appreciated the care he received at Rosary Care Center, especially the constant stream of reading materials.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his brother Cornelius Canavan and his sister Mary Angela Hall.

The Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at Our Lady Queen of Peace Chapel at Lourdes University in Sylvania, OH on Monday, October 24 at 6:00 PM. The chapel will open at 5:00 PM for visitation. Interment will take place at 9:30 AM on Tuesday, October 25 at Resurrection Cemetery, 5725 Hill Ave., Toledo Ohio.
