Edward A. Fromme, 89, passed away peacefully on May 9, 2017 surrounded by his loving family. He was born on December 29, 1927 in Toledo to Herman and Mathilde Fromme.

Eddie graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1945. He attended 2 years of Tailoring School, after proudly serving in the U.S. Army. Eddie married the love of his life, Mary K. Kassmann on June 13, 1959. He worked with his father and brother at the family business, Herman Fromme & Sons Custom Tailoring, located in the Spitzer building in downtown Toledo for over 60 years.

Eddie was involved in the Toledo Ice Yacht Club as a lifetime member, the Lions Club for over 50 years and the Rebel Sailing Association . He was the National Rebel Champion in 1969. He was a longtime member of St. Patrick of Heatherdowns church. Eddie was also an avid fisherman on Devil's Lake most of his life.

Surviving are his wife Mary, daughters Christine (Richard) Doyle and Cindy Fromme, quadruplet grandsons, Matthew, Patrick, Nicholas and Anthony Doyle. They were the pride of his life!
