



## Edwin Francis Durivage

June 18, 1925 - July 25, 2024

Edwin F. Durivage passed away on July 25, 2024 at the age of 99 in Waterville, Ohio. He was born on June 18, 1925 at St. Vincent's Hospital to Edwin F. Durivage, Sr. and Anne (Hummel). He attended Catholic grade school at St. Charles, St. Teresa, and St. James. Within weeks of graduating from Libbey High School, he enlisted in the Army Air Corps. After service, he attended Bowling Green State University, and the University of Toledo. Soon after, he purchased Toledo Oxygen & Equipment Co. and held ownership until 1997.

In 1956 he married Mary Grady. Mary passed in 2004. In 2010 he married Audrey Braham who lost her husband Deacon Carl Braham, in 2000.

Ed was an avid golfer. His golf memberships included Heatherdowns and Toledo Country Clubs where he also served on their boards. A longtime member of The Toledo Club, he also belonged to the Toledo Symphony's Kobacker Society, the Science Society at Imagination Station, and was a supporter of The Toledo Museum of Art, the Toledo Zoo, Central Cities Ministries, and a member of Rotary Club of Toledo.

He was predeceased by his first wife Mary, by parents Edwin and Anne, step-father Jack Caveney, sister Evelyn Grady and brother James. He is survived by his wife Audrey and her four children Cheryl Day, Caren (Bill) Cantrell, Christine (Greg) Caryer, and Charles Braham and all of their children as well as many nieces and nephews.
