Sister Gloria Marie Rowe (Gloria Ann Rowe) died peacefully at the Toledo Hospital on Monday February 4, 2013, after a brief illness. She was born on February 27, 1949 in Springfield, Ohio to Melvin and Ethel (Farrand) Rowe. Before entering the Monastery Sister worked at the Springfield Public Library. She entered the Monastery of the Visitation in May 1983 and made her temporary profession January 21, 1986 and her solemn profession October 7, 1989. Sister Gloria Marie served her sisters as Infirmarian, Assistant to the Superior, Councilor, and sacristan and for many years had charge of the Host Room.

Sister was preceded in death by her parents. Surviving are her sister Peggy (Kenny) Walls, her brothers Rick (Lily) Rowe and Mark Rowe, and many nieces and nephews.
