Jack D. Vandermark 74 of Findlay, Ohio, passed away Sunday June 11, 2017 at the Laurels of Toledo Rehabilitation Center. Born in Monticello, New York on November 30, 1942 to George and Mildred Vandermark, Jack attended Monticello High School graduating in 1961. After graduation he attended the Culinary Institute of America in New Haven, Connecticut. Jack served in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Diamondhead and the USS Annapolis during the early days of the Vietnam era.

After his time in the service, he returned to Monticello where he married Barbara Starr. He worked for IBM in Poughkeepsie, New York for 15 years. Eventually Jack and his family settled in Findlay, Ohio where he worked for Marathon Oil and Bridgestone APM. He also attended the Findlay 1st Assembly of God Church.

Jack was preceded in death by his parents and brother Dennis. He is survived by his wife of 50 years Barbara; sons Michael and Jeremy (Jennifer) Vandermark; brother Keith (Evelyn); sister-in-law Elaine; five grandchildren and four step-granddaughters; as well as numerous nephews and a niece.
