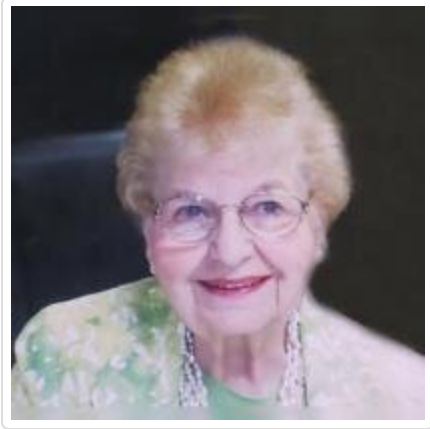




Jacquelyn J Harbauer

Our beloved Jacquelyn Jean Harbauer, a dedicated sister, aunt, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother and friend was called to heaven on the morning of Tuesday, March 19, 2024 at the age of 94. Jackie graduated from Notre Dame Academy and earned her Bachelor of Science Degree in Dietetics from The University of Toledo. She was a member of the Sigma Alpha Omega Honorary Society.

Jackie married Lawrence H. Harbauer in February, 1953 and together they were blessed with 6 children: Candace, Cheryl Fry, Gregory (Debra), Cynthia, Kirk (Susan) and Karen Kay Harbauer. bridge, actively supporting social activities for physically and mentally challenged individuals and spending time with family and friends. She was a blessing to everyone and will be greatly missed.

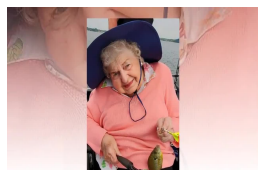
