James Joseph Mack, 70 died peacefully on September 15, 2015 after a long and courageous battle with cancer. He was surrounded by his loving family at Hospice of NW Ohio. Jim was born in Toledo, Ohio on October 5, 1944 to Clarence A. and Olive M. (Wagenknecht) Mack.

He was a graduate of Central Catholic High School, and earned his bachelor's degree and his MBA from the University of Toledo. Jim proudly served his country in the United States Air Force in the Vietnam War. He was a member of the 23rd Tactical Fighter Wing, the 562nd Fighter Squadron, known as the Flying Tigers, and the Tactical Air Command. Jim was a member of the American Legion, the Masons and a life member of the VFW.

Jim worked over 25 years for Chrysler Automotive in labor relations, and with the skilled trades as a human resource manager and training program coordinator. He earned the prestigious Lee Iacocca award for his leadership. He will be remembered for his love of his family, as a fantastic father and husband. He was an avid Ohio State Buckeye fan and fisherman. He was a proud vet, little league football coach and superb handyman.

Jim is survived by his wife and love of his life, Linda, his beloved children Gina (Mike) Rouen, and Tony (Leslie) Mack, and his granddaughters Carlee and Alexa. Many nieces and nephews also survive.
