January 31, 1930 - October 14, 2010

Jerry Redding passed away peacefully on October 14, 2010 surrounded by his family after a battle with cancer. He was born January 31, 1930 to Maurice T. and Helen M. (Snyder) Redding. He graduated from Central Catholic High School. Jerry was a journeyman Tool and Die maker and studied methods, process engineering, estimating, tool design and mathematics at University of Toledo. He was a former V.P. General Manager of the Pilliod Company in Swanton, Ohio, and foreman and estimator for L & J Tool of Toledo. After retirement he worked as an estimator for E & C Manufacturing. Jerry served in the US Navy as a torpedo man on the submarine USS Cutlass. He enjoyed singing, especially with the Toledo Symphony choral for 25 years.

Jerry is survived by his loving wife of 58 years Mary Jane (Park), brother Tom (Nancy) Redding, sister Maureen (Dr. Tom) Williams, and sister-in-law Viola Redding.
