May 10, 1918 - March 19, 2014

Joe G. Limon, 95 years of south Toledo, passed away on Wednesday March 19, 2014 at the Hospice of Northwest Ohio inpatient Center in Toledo. Joe was born in Allende, Jalisco Mexico on May 10, 1918 to Manuel and Magdalena (Garcia) Limon and moved to the U.S. at the age of 4. He served in the United States Air Force during WWII. He worked as a foreman for the Toledo Terminal R.R. for over 40 years.

Joe was preceded in death by his wife Rafaela; he is survived by daughters Carmen (Dan) Worline, Rose Carnes and special granddaughters Rafaela Worline, Robin (Mauricio) Worline. He is also survived by many grandchildren, great grandchildren and great-great-grandchildren.
