John J. Halleron (Jake), 80, of Toledo, Ohio (Bayonet Point, FL) passed away peacefully from natural causes on July 26th, 2014. John was born on December 18th, 1933 to James and Margaret (Foy) Halleron, both deceased. He is preceded in death by his loving wife, Beverly Halleron, brother, James Halleron, his stepson Leslie “Butch” Mahr.

Jake graduated from Immaculate Conception (‘Darby) elementary, Central Catholic H.S. and, then Macomber H.S. He served in the United States Army from 1957-59. He was a member of the Elks in Hudson, FL and a member of the Toledo Sailing Club.

Jake worked for CSX Railroad as a railroad engineer for 43 years.
