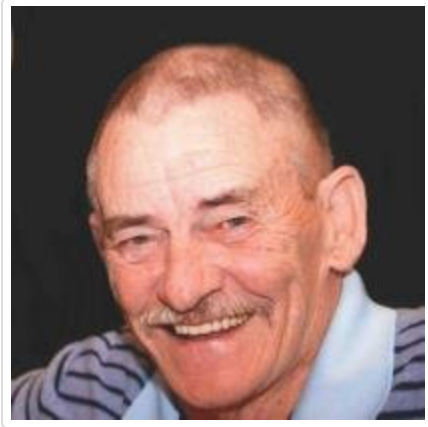




John Thomas Oien
