

Kenneth Lewis Boldt

May 16, 1942 - April 22, 2023

Kenneth "Ken" L. Boldt, "Papa", 80 years, of Perrysburg, Ohio, died suddenly on Saturday, April 22, 2023 at St. Anne's Hospital. Ken was born in Toledo, Ohio on May 16, 1942 to Rolland E. and May (Guthrie) Boldt. He graduated from Libbey High School in 1960 and attended The University of Toledo. Ken was married for 40 years to his high school sweetheart Jo Anne Iler, who preceded him in death in 2005. Ken worked for LinoTrim before working for more than 25 years as a branch manager for Beaver Distributors, wholesalers of ceramic tile. He also worked as a courier for 5/3 Bank until his retirement in 2017. 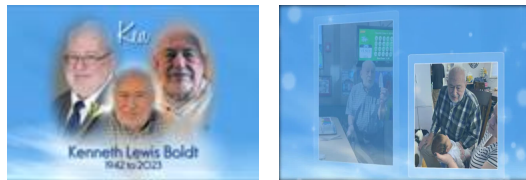
