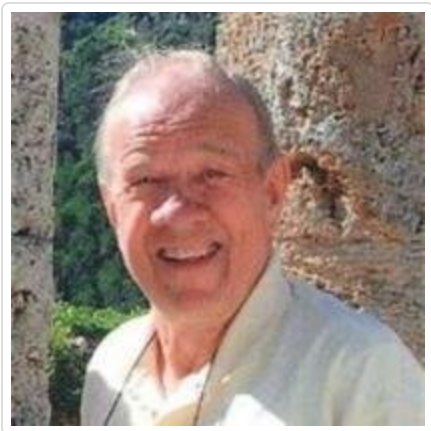




Mark Francis Hohenbrink

February 8, 1932 - May 2, 2012

Mark F. Hohenbrink, 80 years of Maumee Ohio, passed away on Wednesday morning May 2, 2012 in Advanced Specialty Hospital after a long illness. He was born in Delphos Ohio on February 8, 1932 to Frank and Mary Hohenbrink. He served in the United States Army during the Korean War. He was a graduate of the University of Detroit and completed post graduate studies at the University of Toledo.

Mark was a chemical engineer for British Petroleum for many years before retiring in 1994. He was an avid cyclist, biking for several thousands of miles each year. He loved to garden and was a member of two bowling leagues where he enjoyed spending time with many friends.

Mark was preceded in death by his parents; son Mark W. Hohenbrink; sisters Elva Sheets, Mary Ann Donley and brother John Hohenbrink. 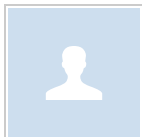

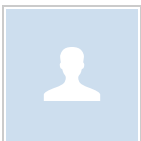
