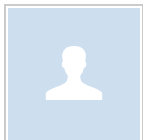
of Heatherdowns Church. Entombment Resurrection Cemetery. Memorials may take the form of contributions to St. Patrick of Heatherdowns Church.

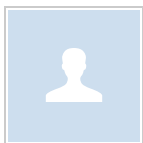
