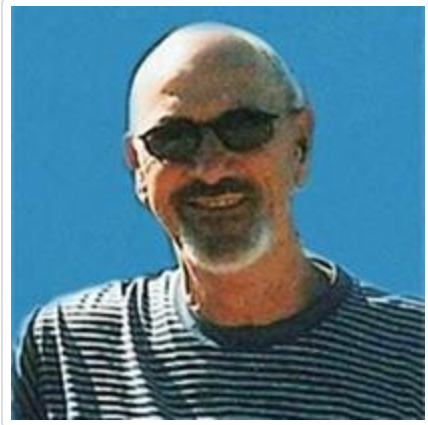




Michael R. Konz
