Michelle passed away Sunday, November 10, 2013 at the age of 49 years and one week, after a brief battle with cancer. Those who know and loved her will miss her energy, her smiles and her determination to do things her way. She died doing what she loved to do, cruising with her family. She leaves a void in the lives of her family as well as all those who knew her.

She loved travel and theatre. She surrounded herself with family and friends who shared her passions. Michelle's life was one of unconditional love and she will be dearly missed by all those that knew her, including her family, patients, their families and her many friends far and wide. She was the family reunion coordinator and family photographer, keeping her memories for everyone. Her annual Christmas letter was a bright spot in everyone's mailbox, as she chronicled her year's travels, adventures and family additions.

Michelle was fiercely independent, a woman of great strength and strong faith. She loved life and loved people. All who knew her know that she truly did leave this world a better place.

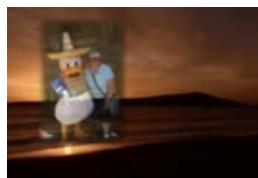
