Nancy M. Cairl, age 86 of Whitehouse, Ohio, passed away peacefully on February 1, 2025, surrounded by her family.

She was born in Toledo, Ohio, on February 12, 1938 to Peter and Mary Tessarz who had immigrated to the United States from Germany. Nancy graduated from Central Catholic High School. Nancy met Norm, the love of her life, at age 16, when she was walking with friends near the World Theatre on Monroe Street. While driving his 1937 Ford, Norm noticed Nancy and honked his ooga car horn at her. Later, Norm was drafted, and Nancy wrote him every day for two years, and the rest is history. They got married on November 20, 1959.

She worked for Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, as branch manager, for over 26 years. Upon retirement, she enjoyed helping raise her grandchildren and traveling with her husband. She also enjoyed baking, sewing, crocheting and loved Christmas time.

She was an active member of St. Charles Borromeo Church and choir. In 1996, she traveled to Rome with the choir where they had an audience with

Pope John Paul II. She cherished the medals and rosary he blessed. She wore the medals everyday and slept with them pinned to her pajamas.
