Patrick Francis McManamon died on January 18, 2010 at Hospice of Northwest Ohio. May he rest in peace with the Lord he loved so well. Patrick was born March 1, 1935 of Patrick J. and Mary (Berry) McManamon, County Mayo, Ireland. He entered the Society of Jesus in 1953. Patrick's lifelong passion was the gospel call to peace and justice. He always surrounded himself with family and friends, especially those who worked for peace. He used his keen intellect to research issues of social justice and liked to contribute some wisdom to the great questions. In reflecting on his life, he hoped that he did not contribute to the chalice of suffering; rather, that he contributed kindness, joy, some laughter to each person he met.

He leaves his beloved wife Mary (McCune) McManamon, a sister Sr. Ann, H.M., a brother Thomas J. (Rosemarie), and many devoted nieces, nephews, relatives, and friends.
