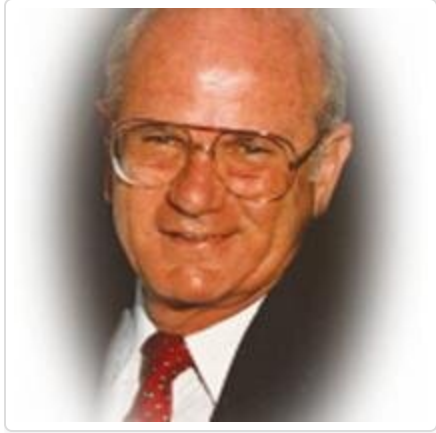




Robert Joseph Nolan

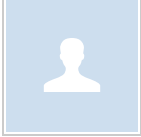
