June 5, 1925 - February 1, 2016

Robert A. Rossi, Sr. 90, passed away surrounded by his family at Flower Hospital February 1, 2016. He was born June 5, 1925 in St. Paul, Minn. to Eugene and Julia Rossi.

Robert served in the U.S. Marine Corps at the battle of Iwo Jima during WWII and was awarded two purple hearts.

Robert graduated from the University of Michigan with two bachelor degrees and a master's degree in engineering. He was the first student to graduate from U of M with straight A's in mathematics. He was a registered professional engineer and surveyor. Robert was also an avid Michigan football fan and liked spending time at Hilton Head Island.

He founded the firm Rossi and Nickerson, Engineers and Architects in 1960.

The firm was responsible for the design of several buildings including the Medical College of Ohio Teaching Hospital, Mercy Hospital, Dana Corp. World Headquarters and Manufacturing facilities, several Whirlpool Corp.

Manufacturing Plants, Philips Display facilities and St. Joan of Arc Church where he was a member.

Robert is preceded in death by his parents Eugene and Julia Rossi; brothers Eugene and Richard; and a son Robert Rossi, Jr. He is survived by his wife of 67 years Mary Charlotte "Polly"; children Mary Jane (Jim) Walton, Brad (Wanda), Scot (Karen Dunne), Jill (Edward Smith); grandchildren Lisa Stambaugh, David Stambaugh, Robert Andrew Rossi III, Adam Rossi, Colin Rossi, Nicholas Bratton and Julie Bratton.
