Robert William Zoski age 65 of Toledo passed away suddenly in his home. Born October 4, 1947, he was proud to call Trilby, Ohio his boyhood home and remembered well life there before the City of Toledo annexed the area. He was a 1965 graduate of Whitmer High School. He joined the 20th Corp Army Engineers in 1966 and was later transferred to the 86th ARCOM. Bob worked for many years at the former DeVilbiss Co. until the plant closed and moved in 1989. He married Margaret "Maggie" Ketterman on June 5, 1971 and were divorced in 1994. Bob then moved to south Toledo where he worked as a handyman for many years.
