Steve Krauser, 70 years, of South Toledo passed away unexpectedly, but at great peace in his home, Monday April 27, 2009.

Steve had a great passion for life. He shared that through his 46 years of marriage to Sharon and with his children Debbie, Steve, Jr. and Missy, their families and with many friends and acquaintances.

Steve was born and raised in Toledo having attended Ladyfield School, St. Francis de Sales High School and the University of Toledo where he graduated with a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration.

While at St. Francis and as a member of the first graduating class, Steve was a tremendous athlete who along with an outstanding group of young men earned that school almost instant respectability in athletics during those early years. His great speed and toughness allowed him to have great success as a tailback in football, contribute to the basketball team and run track and field.

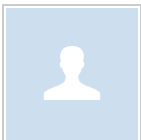
