December 26, 1933 - January 2, 2015

Stephen B. Rodriguez died unexpectedly of a brain aneurysm on Friday, January 2, 2015. At the time of his passing, he was surrounded by the peaceful love of his family. He was 81 years old.

Steve was born in Toledo, Ohio on December 26, 1933 to Juan Mendoza and Ursula (Lupercio) Rodriguez. He attended Libbey High School and enlisted in the Navy in 1955. In the Navy, Steve had many adventures and enjoyed telling of them. In 1987, after 32 years, he retired from the Dura Corporation as a timekeeper. He was strong in his Catholic faith and enjoyed being a nursing home Eucharistic minister. As a natural athlete, he was an avid golfer, tennis player and coach. And he was always willing to share valuable tips on how to improve your game.

Steve lived his life by the traditional standards of hard work, respect and responsibility. He had a noble moral compass and always tried to do the right thing. Above all, Steve valued family love and togetherness. He instilled all these ideals in his children and so his legacy lives on.
