



Thomas Adrian Dixon

July 26, 1934 - January 11, 2017

Thomas A. Dixon, age 82, died peacefully on January 11, 2017. He was born in Toledo, Ohio, on July 26, 1934, to Herman and Viola (Carter) Dixon.

Tom grew up in the “Old Darby” neighborhood, a member of Immaculate Conception Parish. Tom received his “honorary” Libbey High School diploma, bestowed by Congresswoman Marcy Kaptur to those individuals who left high school early to enlist in the military. He proudly served his country in the United States Navy during the Korean War. Following Honorable discharge from the Navy, Tom went to work on the New York Central Railroad. Work on the railroad and the friendships gained were an important part of his life.

In 1954, Tom married Gladys Jeakle, his high school sweetheart. Together, they raised six children in a household where there was rarely a dull moment. Tom and Glad were also blessed with countless valued and longstanding friendships, many dating back to grade school. Tom retired from Conrail in 1993, and after those years of crazy railroad work hours, retirement was a fun and carefree time. Together, they enjoyed family and friends, long vacations, and spoiling their grandchildren and great-grandchildren. Tom will be remembered for his love of golf (1998 hole-in-one!) and Notre Dame football, being the life of the party, and his general shenanigans.
