Thomas "Tom" Allen Ghaster, 85, died peacefully in his home on August 20, 2023. Tom was born on September 26, 1937 to Harvey and Margaret (Minard) Ghaster. He proudly served his country in the US Navy. He served as a Scout Master for Little Flower Church in the late 1960's-mid 1970's.
