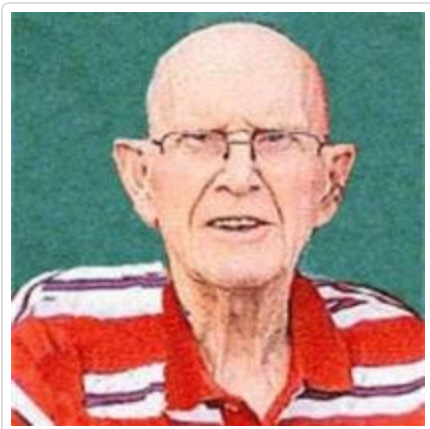




Thomas Joseph Walsh
