Timothy S. Hohl, 47, of Toledo passed away on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at St. Luke's Hospital with his parents and close buddies by his side. Tim was born in Bridgeport, CT on March 25, 1974 to Jeff and Raeanne Hohl. Tim attended Our Lady of Perpetual Help grade school and was a 1992 graduate of St. John's Jesuit High School where he played football, basketball and baseball. Tim attended Ohio Wesleyan University and graduated with a degree in Journalism. He was a member of the Sigma CHI Fraternity (In Hoc) and pitched four years on the Battling Bishops baseball team.

Tim work in the logistic industry for various companies, most recently with The Hub Group as a Carrier Representative. Seems as if he was always working, whether it was as a caddy at Toledo Country Club, mowing lawns for the Andersons, or customer service and sales for Owens Corning. Tim gravitated to the logistics industry where he spent the majority of his working life.
