Jack Barr, age 85 of Toledo, Ohio passed from this life on March 9, 2010 at Foundation Park Care Center.

Born on July 9, 1924 at St. Vincent Hospital, the son of Abigail and Walter Barr, he was raised in Toledo and was a Scott High School graduate. Jack being a patriotic young man with a great love for his country, enlisted in the U.S. Army in February of 1943 at age 19. He was placed in the Medical Corp and honorably received 2 Bronze Service Stars. At war's end, Jack remained in Germany working as a Tech at the 98th General U.S. Medical Hospital. After coming back to the States, he became a loyal employee of the Champion Spark Plug Company for 40 years retiring in January 1988. A member of St. Clement Parish for many years and he was also a member of the Elks Lodge #53 since 1995.

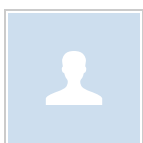

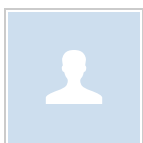

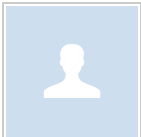
